Specialty Populations Served: *Medical rehabilitation* – acquired brain injury, complex wound care, stroke/CVA, complex medical including dialysis, pulmonary disease including ventilator/tracheotomy weaning, multiple trauma including orthopedic injuries. *Child/adolescent residential* – neurobehavioral and neuropsychiatric, cognitive and developmentally delayed, brain
