Our topic this month “**Acute Stroke Care and Stroke Presentation**” presented by **Dr. David Morledge**. Dr. Morledge will cover: What is a Stroke/TIA, causes of strokes, field assessment (pre-hospital), acute management, acute therapy, general stroke management and stroke statistics. He will also cover the complications of strokes and the prevention of the second stroke.
