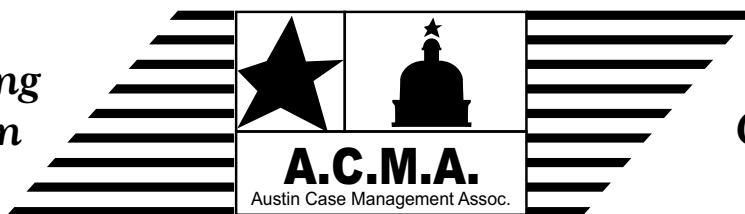

Our topic this month is Topic is "Carpal Tunnel Syndrome" presented by Stephen Rose, MD. Carpel Tunnel Syndrome is the most common nerve compression disorder of the upper extremity according to the National Center for Health Statistics. This process effects 1 percent of the general population and 5 percent of the working population who must undergo repetitive use of their hands and wrists in daily living. Carpal Tunnel Syn-

drome results in the highest number of days lost among all work related injuries. Topics will include diagnosis and latest advancement in treatment options for Carpal Tunnel and other nerve compression syndromes of the upper extremity. .
